

## Requirements List



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- Top Fabric, you determine the size of your quilt. Please add 2-4 inches of fabric on all 4 sides. Go wild with your colour but not your pattern! Busy fabrics hide your hard work so rather go plain!
- Backing fabric, 3-4 inches bigger than the top on all 4 sides. Here you can crazy! The wilder the better as it hides your wobbles! 100% cotton backing fabric is the safe and easiest option.
- 2 layers of batting of your choice, the same size as your backing fabric. Polyester is fine but if you have cotton or cotton blend you can use that too. Using 2 layers gives great texture if you want to try it.
- Thread to match your top fabric is the safe choice but nothing stops you from going bold and wild or subtle in the thread colours. A good quality thread that you know works well with your machine will be great.
- 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray or safety pins to baste
- White chalk pen/pencil/marker
- Blue fabric pen/water erasable pen
- Masking tape
- Sewing Machine/quilt machine cleaned and oiled
- At least 2 bobbins
- Free motion quilting or embroidery or darning foot & walking foot
- Sewing machine needles Top Stitch 90 or Universal 90 or Quilting 90 & similar for longarm machine

## Requirements List

- Unpicker
- Quilting gloves or paddles or spots (for sit-down & domestic machine quilters)
- Quilting rulers if you have
- Ruler foot if you have
- Prym Fray Check if you have
- Pounce pad in white
- Any grid stencils you might have
- 10-12 sheets of acetate (or a thin stencil plastic) (old overhead transparency sheets)
- Fine tip permanent marker
- Micro fibre cloth
- Soft tape measure
- Small scissors
- Tweezer (to help with unpicking)
- Home Printer and paper
- Lightbox if you have
